We want to carry on making Brighton a good place to live for everybody.



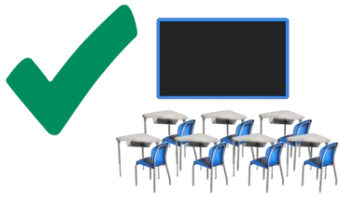
The Conservative government has cut the money it gives to the council.

We have built more council housing so that people have places to live.



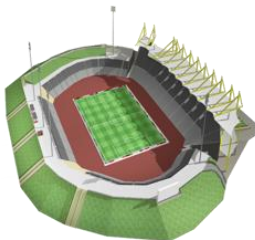
More rubbish is being recycled than before.
